

Instructions for Authors of Journal of Advanced Computational Intelligence & Intelligent Informatics

1. Definition of Journal of Advanced Computational Intelligence & Intelligent Informatics

This publication focuses on advanced computational intelligence & intelligent informatics, including the synergetic integration of neural networks, fuzzy logic and evolutionary computations, so that more intelligent systems can be built for industrial applications.

2. Responsibility for Manuscript

The author alone is responsible for any statements made in the manuscript.

3. Type and Length of Article

- 3.1. Type of Articles acceptable are papers, Development reports, News, Letters, and Reviews.
- 3.2. The number of pages will include the abstract, keywords, tables, figures and photographs.
- 3.3. Papers should present new findings and original concepts with complete discussion. They should normally be 6 printed pages on average and have not been published to date in any other publication.
- 3.4. Development Reports describe technical findings which will actually be useful in practical applications. They should normally be 6 printed pages.
- 3.5. Reviews summarize a specific subject by introducing the author's own views concerning recent progress and future prospects to give a balanced assessment.
- 3.6. News describe incomplete research and include new findings or valuable data. They should normally be no longer than 2 printed pages.

4. Language and Units

- 4.1. The language for contributions is English or Japanese.
- 4.2. SI units are desirable for units, but CGS is also acceptable.

5. Submission of Manuscripts

- 5.1. Manuscripts with all illustrations should be

submitted with 3 copies. All photographs must be original artworks. When accepted author is requested to submit final manuscript. In this case, electronic file submission is requested. details will be send at the time notice of acceptance.

6. Acceptance and Review of Manuscript

- 6.1. The received date is the arrival date of a manuscript, and the accepted date is the approval date for publication by the Editorial Committee.
- 6.2. All submitted manuscripts will be reviewed by the Editorial Committee.

7. Copyright

- 7.1. The copyright of any articles published in Journal of Advanced Computational Intelligence belongs to the publisher.
- 7.2. When the authors want to use their own articles for any purpose in any form, approval in writing must be obtained in advance from Fuji Technology Press Ltd., Publisher.

8. Page Charge

A charge of ¥21,000 (submitted in Japanese) or ¥11,000 (submitted in English) per printed page will be invoiced to the author or author's designated institution.

9. Reprint Order

Reprints can be purchased on request. An application for reprints is made by the order from on returning the galley proof.
