## AIMS & SCOPE

The *Journal of Disaster Research* provides timely, topical information on disasters related to information, lifeline infrastructures, traffic, terror, and similar events not directly due to war. The Journal's target audience is those who fight disaster in their capacity as researchers, engineers, disaster prevention managers, administrators, diplomats, and disaster-related NGO and NPO personnel.

The term "disaster," which comes from the Latin "dis," or "ill," and the Greek "astron," or "star" – hence "ill-starred" – refers to misfortune, adversity, and retribution for disregarding the laws of Nature. This translates as "saigai" in Japanese, where "sai" means malfunction in the expected flow in things and "gai" means nonachievement of things expected. This in turn suggests that social systems, including private lives, are disrupted due to malfunctions in the system. Disaster is thus closely related to all aspects of human life and social activities. The more convenient private life becomes, and the more complex society becomes, the higher the potential for disaster, increasing the importance of disaster prevention.

Disaster prevention has been a vital issue since ancient times. By their nature, microscopic studies on such topics as the earthquake resistance of reinforced concrete structures and macroscopic studies on a broader scope are equally vital. This Journal provides valuable knowledge on disaster prevention and mitigation from a comprehensive, informative viewpoint, with the emphasis on "wide and comprehensive scope."

Targeted papers include research papers, reviews, fact-finding articles, and surveys — the latest information and materials, in other words, related to disaster.

The Journal's language is English because of its global circulation and contributions. Regions of interest center on Japan, but include Asia and areas worldwide.

The *Journal of Disaster Research* is distributed as an "e-journal plus," meaning in printed form and as an e-journal. Materials related to compiled articles are stored in a database to provide subscribers with worthwhile, reliable data.
